From the School Nurse

- Please think about sending in a sweater or hoodie to keep in class as the weather is changing and some rooms are cooler than others.
- Now is the time to contact your health care provider to make an appointment to get your student immunized against flu. We will not be having a Flu Mist Clinic at school this year. However, the importance of preventing flu hasn't changed so please take the time to contact your student's doctor or plan on attending The FREE walk in clinic that will be offered by the Wicomico County Health Department later in the fall.
- Allergy & Asthma season are here. Monitor all symptoms closely and follow your health care provider's advice. Medical care plans, rescue inhalers, and Epi pens are a necessity, and may save a life!
- If your student has a health condition or needs special care during the school day such as medication, treatments, or monitoring, please inform the school nurse. Individual health care plans help keep your students safe and healthy.
